ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSES

<u>IUNIOR:</u> To be aged between 12 & 16 years. A Junior must be capable of opening and shutting all gates, able to draft, and completing the course by themselves. They may have an adult standing with them for advise only. Parents are required to sign an entry form on their behalf before they trial.

ENCOURAGE: An Encourage handler may win two[2] Encourage class trials in total. An Encourage handler may win one[1] Encourage class trial with a dog that has won a trial of a higher class.

<u>MAIDEN</u>: Once a dog has won a Maiden, he/she is then graded "Novice" and can no longer compete in the Maiden Class. A Maiden dog may be nominated in a Novice Class at the discretion of the trial convenor. The winner of the Maiden Class may compete in the Novice Class on the day at the discretion of the trial convenor.

NOVICE: Once A dog has won a Novice Class, he/she is the graded Improver and can no longer compete in the Novice Class. A Novice dog cannot be nominated in an Improver or Open Class.

IMPROVER: Once a dog has won an Improver Class, he/she is then graded Öpen" and can no longer compete in the Improver Class. An Improver class dog may enter the Open Class.

<u>OPEN:</u> Dogs that have won their novice & improver classes.

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP: Current SAYDA State Champion. Dogs that have qualified by winning an open event at a SAYDA affiliated trial in the period since the previous State Championship. The top placings from an Open event conducted in conjunction with the trial.

ALL COMPETITORS ENTERING IN THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS HAVE TO BE A MEMBER OF SAYDA.
